

## TENDER DEADLY VOICES

**ANOTHER MIDAS** return to the South Hill Park with another world premiere following their outrageous five star hits *Dirty...* *Little...* *Secrets* (2003) and Chaucer's *COCK TALE* (2004). This time they retell the Greek myth of the Sirens, bringing straight into the 21<sup>st</sup> Century. Small groups of audience members will walk around the lake with a Siren and a Sailor, and will witness the enduring love story and its inevitable tragic conclusion.

**TENDER DEADLY VOICES**, will be an all new work that fuses contemporary devising techniques with classical performance training to create an innovative, accessible and immersive world. 'Genre Busting' (*The Scotsman*) **Another Midas** embrace highly stylised physical theatre coupled with rich text by local talent **Harper Ray** and an integrated new musical score by Jim Fowler, composer with the BAFTA winning Sony team.

Audience members start their journey seated at tables in a fisherman's tavern, where they are regaled with salty tales of shipwrecks past, before the operatic Sirens call you to the shores of the lake where the rest of the gothic myth unfolds in mythic proportions. The highlight of the piece will be an opera aria sung from a siren floating on the water. With innovative storytelling, an all new musical score and a flair for the 'Visually spectacular' (*Sunday Times*) Five Star theatre company Another Midas bring a touch of magic to South Hill Park. **TENDER DEADLY VOICES** is the classic Greek tale of the Sirens like you have never heard it before.
